The Committee entered the non-public at 7:28 p.m.

There was a general discussion of the applicants may not have public sector experience with a general opinion being the private sector experience may still have substantial merit.

The Chair introduced the name of each of the 22 candidates with a general discussion before the members were polled to rank them as Yes, Maybe or No for an interview. After the first round a second review was conducted of the Maybe candidates. The end result was that candidates #1, 3, 4, 17, 19, and 22 were to be invited in for interviews.

It was decided that those would be on 05/04, 05/11 and 05/18. The group would convene at 6 p.m. to regroup on any "resume Specific" questions that would be asked in addition to the 15 formal interviews and scored questions. Those questions would be presented to eth candidates 15 minutes ahead of time. The candidates would then have to pace themselves through the questions (in order) over the course of their allotted 45 minute interview time.

The Town Administrator stated a concern that, while he understood the committee's desire to not get burnt out doing too many interviews on an evening, if these candidates were applying with us they might be applying elsewhere and an extended interview schedule might lose some candidates. The general consensus was to stay with the scheduled as set.
